## RELATIONAL CARE | Meeting personal needs at life's crucial intersections

### Mission & Values

Relational Care shares God's heart and Cedarview's passion for ministering to individuals and families experiencing significant life events – births, hospitalization, life-altering illness, death and bereavement. Our ministry staff handles initial care and trained volunteers assist with follow up. The goal of Relational Care is that every person in the Cedarview family receives a relational touch when navigating through significant life events.

### Scope Of Ministry

- Pastor-on-Call (24/7 support)
- Births, Adoptions, and Baby Registry (personal connection, instructional resources, and post birth follow up)
- Hospital Ministry
- Critical Care (ongoing care related to life-altering illness or situation)
- Deaths, Funeral Planning & Hosting
- Bereavement Care and Resources (GriefShare & Grief Recovery)
- Intercessory Prayer Team (Relational Care needs)
- Personalized Gifts for Critical Care Patients, Bereavement, and Hospitalization (prayer cards, flowers, books, sermons on CD/DVD, etc.)

### Four Foundational Lessons

- A systematic approach is the only way to be effective and faithful in a ministry of caring.
- Follow up opportunities are often more meaningful and relational than the initial touch.
- Small gifts, cards and other expressions of love dramatically impact persons facing life-changing events.
- Volunteers are essential in supporting church staff to ensure high-quality care for a diverse congregation.

## CELEBRATE RECOVERY

### Mission & Values

Celebrate Recovery was founded by Pastor John Baker at Saddleback Church in California in 1991, and is now in 29,000+ churches around the world, with more than three million participants and graduates. Celebrate Recovery will be a once-a-week program on Mondays for anyone who has a hurt, hang-up, or bad habit, for instance: Relationship problems: divorce, co-dependency, emotional abuse, physical abuse. Addictions: over-working, over-eating, overspending, alcohol and drug abuse, food addiction, sexual addictions, gambling. Emotional challenges: anxiety, depression, control issues, anger, guilt, bitterness, unforgiveness, fear, and chronic illness. And of course, denial.

Celebrate Recovery is a Christian program, and follows the classic, Bible-based Twelve Steps. Confidentiality and a supportive environment are key. When the CR meetings begin, all persons, age 18 and over, Christian and non-Christian, will be welcome as participants. CR is not only for our Cedarview members, but is a mission to our local community.

### Requirements

On July 2, 2017, at the end of his morning sermon, Pastor Don Horban said, "You cannot be a true Christ-following disciple without ministry to others. Ministry to others is a doorway to grace. How many lives should you be touching by now?"

With Pastor Don's words in mind, you are invited to volunteer for CELEBRATE RECOVERY, a new program coming to Cedarview. We need motivated Christians to begin training for the CR Leadership / Teaching team, and for the CR Share Group Leaders team. We need to hear from you NOW.

### Volunteer Criteria:

- Would you like to deepen your walk in Christ through service and participation in this ministry?
- Are you ready to start work on the Christian Twelve Steps as a process of development/spiritual formation, and to familiarize yourself with the CR program?
- Are you experienced? Christians who are in recovery from any of the hurts, hang-ups, and habits are especially valuable as volunteers.

We will also need volunteers for the Celebrate Recovery Worship team, AV team, Greeters, Setup, Resources team, Prayer Team, Cafe Team, Childcare Team
